NEBOSH National Diploma

Duration of study

1 day a week for 2 years

Start date

September or January

Entry requirements

NEBOSH General Certificate or equivalent Level 3. It is preferred that applicants are working in, or intend to be working within the field of Occupational Health and Safety. You will be required to attend an interview.

How will I study?

This course is a vocational study of the essential knowledge and understanding required of those working in the Health and Safety sector. An example of the units studied include: the management of risk, legal and occupational factors, the workplace and work equipment.

How am I assessed?

The assessment process comprises both continuous assessment and examination. Assignments and examinations are set by NEBOSH and relate to your working experience.

What can I do after the course?

Successful completion of the Diploma will enhance your career prospects and will allow application to the Institute of Occupational Health and Safety, Corporate Membership. It will enable you to manage complex risks within an organisation.



Health and Safety Practice

NVQ Level 4

Duration of study

Attendance is flexible based around a series of 'workshops'. It is expected that the NVQ will be completed within a year. One module per month.

Start date

September or January

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements. This course is aimed at those who are already working within the Occupational Health and Safety sector.

How will I study?

This course has a vocational approach that will underpin your practical experience with various theoretical applications. An example of the subject areas, include: health and safety policies, practical problem solving, working relationships and risk control.

How am I assessed?

Assessment is via the production of a portfolio of evidence to be verified by the Assessor. There are no formal examinations.

What can I do after the course?

Upon successful completion of the course, you will enhance your career prospects within Health and Safety industries. The NVQ Level 4 provides the evidence for full corporate membership of IOSH.

Environmental Management Diploma

Duration of study

8 months

Start date

November or April

Entry requirements

A minimum of NEBOSH Diploma Part 1 or other relevant qualifications. It is preferred that candidates have environmental management responsibilities as part of their job role.

How will I study?

This course is a vocational study of environmental issues within the workplace. An example of the study areas include management and environmental risk, legal and organisational factors and environmental control measures.

How am I assessed?

Assessment is a combination of written assignment and examination set by NEBOSH.

What can I do after the course?

This course will underpin and build upon your current knowledge and work experience and will therefore enhance career opportunities within Occupational Health and Safety.
