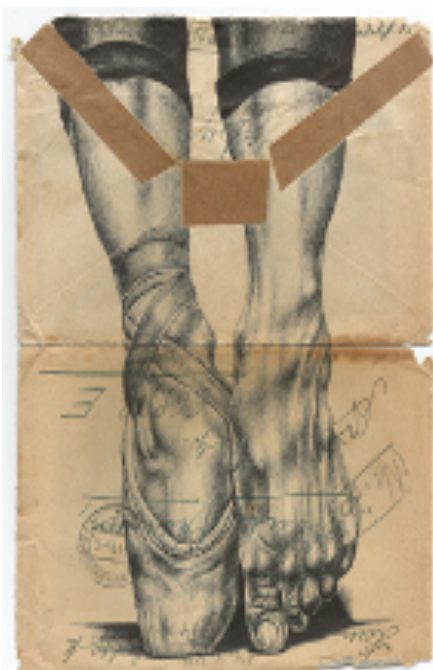


Level 3 Art and Design

Observational skills are so important in all areas of art and design, understanding how shape, space, form, colour and line work together will help you to develop both art and design skills; from painting pictures to designing buildings! This is why drawing from real objects (not from photographs) is fundamental to your learning.

Find a variety of objects to explore through drawing, try to gather a range of different textures and surfaces. Find something reflective, something dull, something smooth, something rough. Explore different mediums too such as biro, pencil, fine liner, felt tips – whatever you have available! You can also explore drawing on different surfaces, such as tea stained paper, old book pages and the back of envelopes.
